Tree guards offer protection to trunks and tall plants from wildlife damage, especially during the 'rut' season. Deer rub their antlers on the trees, causing damage to the bark.

Bird Netting is a loose poly mesh material that is both a lightweight and affordable barrier to minimize bird damage to plants and landscape.

Tick Prevention

Deer are the most common carriers of tick-borne illnesses in the United States, spreading debilitating tick diseases to herd members as well as livestock animals, pets and humans. Ticks can be found in grasslands, wetlands and woodlands during the warmer months beginning in March. They stay alive by burying themselves underneath the skin of a warm-blooded mammal, which elevates the risk of tick-borne illnesses.

Although ticks are most active in the spring and summer months, they do not die when the temperature goes below freezing. Instead, ticks become dormant and seek warmth by feeding on mammals, hiding below logs or underneath leaves.

Lyme Disease, the most common tick-borne illness, is a very dangerous disease that can turn life threatening from a single tick bite. In 2015 alone, the CDC reported 37,000 Lyme Disease cases from 14 states in the upper Midwest and Northeast region. Although these states carry the most reported Lyme Disease cases in North America, it is possible for persons living in other states to pick-up a tick-borne illness from an infected animal.

The Safest Method For Tick Removal Is To Use A Tick Removal Tool Or Tweezers.



DON'T twist. jerk, tug or crush the tick



Grasp the tick as close as possible to the head



Pull firmly to remove the whole tick



DON'T use your fingernail to try to remove the tick



Consult your doctor or veterinarian for next steps



Wear insect repellent while hiking



DON'T use lit matches, nail polish, or other folk remedies



Use flea and tick medicine for your pets



Always check for ticks after visiting areas where ticks may be located
